MESSAGE

After tremendous success of B2V3, the UT government led by my Hon'ble LG Shri Manoj Sinha Ji sir has vigorously launched Fourth phase of this 8-day long programme of Back to Village (B2V4) commencing from 27th October, 2022. The programme mainly focuses on four broad objectives-

1. Energizing all 4291 panchayats of the UT
2. Collecting quality feedback on delivery of various government schemes
3. Capturing economic potential of the panchayats to synchronize them with decentralization goals
4. Undertaking unbiased assessment of needs of villages

Worthy Chief secretary of Jammu and Kashmir, Shri Arun Kumar Mehta Sir has stressed that public feedback about the working of government offices in local areas is a significant component of policy making regarding which this programme will play a key role. Other than this, spreading and evaluating awareness among masses about all online portals and prompt services offered by the government and promoting digital literacy and inclusion among the villagers to take benefit of government services and deliverables efficiently would be significant part of this Jan Abhiyan.

The programme methodology covers major visits by various bureaucrats to languishing projects and leading institutions in the panchayat in order to assess the ground situation and submit a comprehensive report regarding the success of various schemes including a holistic view while celebrating involvement of all stakeholders in the policy making. In Kupwara district, 33

prominent officers will be visiting different panchayats. Worthy Deputy Commissioner has expressed his desire to specify exact locations of the programme in such a way that a diversified perspective can be collected. As this is a joint effort and an important outreach initiative to tailor the schemes according to ground realities and improve overall efficiency of service delivery and hence ensure good governance, it is outrightly inevitable that all supporting staff has to ensure that all necessary interactions are facilitated in a way which ensures another massive response along with achievement of all objectives envisaged by visiting officers.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.
7. Focus of visit are youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukt, bhrashtachar mukt, Rozgar yukt J&K, besides to carry forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and saturate them.
8. In addition attention may be given to the following areas
 - a. Make full use of Centrally Sponsored Schemes
 - b. Saturation of individual beneficiary schemes
 - c. Self-employment schemes
 - d. Bank linked schemes- including departmental subsidy schemes

- Incomplete buildings:- During my first day visit to Upper Primary School Dingree Bla there was only one class room for 66 students, which needs very much attention. I saw there teachers take classes in an open field of the school. The school is situated along the road side. The of vehicular movement there might have been disturbance during class work. The plinth of the three room building has been constructed in the year 2021 by the local contractor but he has abandoned the work as such due to unknown reasons, as reported by the Sarpanch of the P. & also verified on ground.
- PHC:- There is a Health Sub centre in the Panchayat (village) and is functioning in a dilapidated building. The centre is without electricity and water. Only 1st Aid service is being provided to the villagers. Inadequate staff, only one nursing orderly performing duty. People demand Health and Welfare Centre with Post of FMPHW and Medical Officer.
- SHG:- met SHG's of the Panchayat. There are about 100 SHG's in the village. They demand for Govt. building and tailoring knitting centres. To strengthen these self help groups vocational and skill development training should be given to these SHG's.
- my school, my pride progress:- Visited all the schools of the Panchayat, met and interacted with the staff and students. Electricity available. Sanitation is proper in the schools. The students and staff put forth many demands and problems like fencing around the schools, repairing of wash rooms, improvement of link roads from main road to school, scarcity of drinking water, repairing of ^{school} kitchens and need of computer labs.

NOTES

→ Panchayat Play ground:- visited Panchayat ground, distributed one sports

kit and participated in two games - Foot ball and Tug of war rope game.

The ground covers an area of 60 kanals and is under construction.

Few Walnut trees existing in ground which needs felling permission

Near about 20 kanals of kahcharai land is still under the

occupation of few households as reported by BDC and Sarpanch and also

verified on ground. In order to retrieve the illegal possession of kahcharai

land it needs the intervention of Tehsildar and Naib Tehsildar as requested

by BDC and Sarpanch. The BDC and Sarpanch also reported that the contractor

abandoned the ^{further} construction work without any reason and urged its completion as soon as possible.

→ Jal Jeevan Mission:- The villagers are being supplied raw water. There remains

scarcity of water. The people demand for construction of SR and filtration plant

and supply of water on regular basis.

→ Shortage of electric poles, transmission wires in some areas and also

need 2 nos of transformers in New colony Bingree was reported and was also verified

on ground.

→ The villagers demand for modernization of some inner links.
