Single health & wellness centre designated for GP is located in another village (Panzmulla). One of the major problem of area is portable drinking water. The various schemes undertaken by JEL Shakti deptt. have not been completed yet. Although improvements have been made in power distribution. Wooden poles have been replaced by Iron poles (electric) in G.P. More needs to be done to improve over Scenario. The GP needs a play ground to direct the energies of youth in a positive direction and to drive them away from drugs.
