
Overall assessment of the visit and suggestions

During my two days visit to Halqa Nehama it was observed that people in general are not aware about different Govt. schemes pertaining to different departments, so they are not getting benefited out of these schemes at large. Rural department is very much visible on ground as most of the works are related by this department. PDD and Jal Shakti (P.H.E.) are making good perception as there is considerable improvement in the services however more hardwork and dedication is needed by the front line workers. People should be made aware about the Govt. schemes pertaining to Agriculture, Horticulture, Forestry, Irrigation, Social welfare, Handicrafts & other departments. People should be made aware about the Entrepreneurship, especially women entrepreneurship in this Halqa. Because Nehama is the hub of business so that more and more youths will start their own enterprises. Nehama market needs some improvements by the Govt. as some businessmen approached me and placed a representation for Street light. So installation of Street light was their dire need. Shortage of staff is felt by all departments in the field. Staff associated with I.C.D.S. rendering services in ~~the~~ satisfactory manner but field staff seems to be disinterested as they are not salaried regularly. The GRS of the Halqa also raised the problem of salary, although they working ~~at~~ ~~satisfactorily~~ satisfactorily. I interacted with the school students at different schools. I found that the teachers are dedicated as the expression of K.G. Classes & 1st Standard shows teachers' dedication. Their (Students) basic concepts are clear in every subject.

In order to overcome shortcomings some suggestions are pendown

1. Staff needed to be strengthened
2. Regular field Camps should be established for ^{organised} schemes of the Govt. depts.

3. Encouraging Aungmye bodies / Public representatives for monitoring the functioning of different departments.
4. Employment department / Industries depts. need to organise public reach out programmes in order to educate people. Govt. subsidised schemes, loan facilities for setting up of Small scale ^{enterprises} and Cottage industries; Skill development programmes in order to bring economic as well social development in the Halqra.


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
