General Assessment

(i) Major Complaints - Generally the people complaint against the various departments for not addressing the issues raised during the earlier three phases of B2V -

The major public demands raised during earlier phases & not addressed so far are

→ Non full fillment of the commitments made by LTHP for providing compensation to the people whose land was acquired by the project authorities for its construction. Moreover the upgradation of the left irrigation scheme & water supply scheme on which work is yet to be started despite the approval for the same.

Establishment of ATM, Shopping complex & Housing colony, upgradation of the playground at Bising, Tile paths at various spots, Chain link fencing on river side near Army camp 173 BN protection band near Jamia Masjid, Land for the construction of new school building. Forward-1, Tile path from the bank of Mohd Yusuf onwards & construction of drain & culvert

Generally the work was comprehensive. The frontline workers of various departments were very active & kept up the smooth running of the 70 days programme, especially the RDD.

The time the people have large expectations from the government, as such it is suggested that the basic demands of the people, which were raised during these phases be full filled so that the faith of the people on government institutions is restored.

Lastly I again thank all RDD & PRI's for their active support
