SHGs

Activity of SHGs creates an alternate source of livelihood in rural areas & plays a vital role in upliftment of women both socially & economically. SHGs are facing major problems in selling of their produce because of absolute lack of permanent market places.

- Inadequate support both from the Panchayat & Govt demoralizes the members.
- Moreover low return on products is also a cause due to poor marketability.
- Limited awareness with regards to new technologies.

Every possible measure should be taken in order to provide a supportive environment for growth & development of SHGs.

The mentioned above SHGs in this Panchayat have no access to a proper permanent market place & their core demand was also the same in order to sell their produce.

JJM & electricity supply.

The village Brahmkalan is facing acute shortage of drinking water facility & residents have developed a rage towards the non-seasonalness of concerned departments in redressal of this burning issue. The water distribution network under JJM is purely a failure here. The water testing agency have clearly reported a high concentration of certain minerals beyond permissible amount in drinking water.

Regarding electricity supply, the village is continuously facing an interrupted supply of electricity for unknown reasons. Moreover the visit of Chakri-brother entangled failure of PDD in replacing wooden poles with Iron poles, hence putting the precious lives under risk.
