



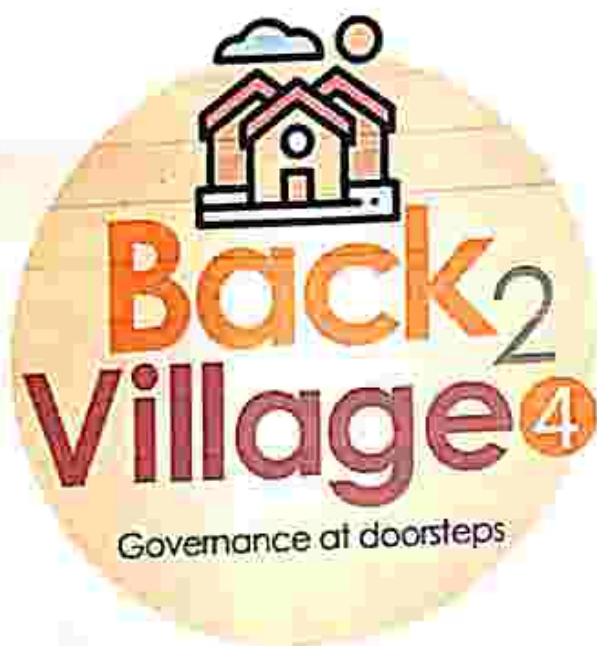

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

I. Drinking and watering schemes Paddy & fruit trees:-

I DRINKING WATER:-

The general public of the village has been demanding installation of 3 bore wells to be installed in Kerewa Wachi for clean and stable water supply and shifting of Kumar Mohalla bore well (which yields muddy, dirty and izey drinking water) to Kerewa near Reservoir (tank). Since the very first Back to village programme but nothing has been done so far. Request for immediate action please.

II WATERING OF PADDY FIELD

& ORCHARDS IN KEREWA WACHI:-

The reconstruction of flood washed WATER FLUME in Zahid bagh wachi has been in Government papers since 2015. Funds for reconstruction stand sanctioned by the government in 2019-20. But the work is not being started till date for want of "acord sanction" from Com/Secretary Jalshakti J&K U.T. Srinagar.

The "back to village programme" authorities are requested to remind the situation to Com./Secretary Jalshakti for release of funds please.

III The government spent Rs. 9 lac for repairs of the canal running through orchards in Kerewa in 2020-2021 but it is leaking water in bed resulting in damage of fruit trees growing nearby. The bottom of the canal needs repairs. The govt is requested to look into it.

2. Removal of Keekar - trees grown both sides of wachi - Darbagh link road on karewa.

The load carrying autos and vehicles cannot run on the road due to self-grown keekar trees on both sides of the link - road. The concerned department is requested for early action please.

3. Flood protection Bhand:-

Since the very first "Back to village programme" the government was requested for repairs/completion of the bhand particularly in Rakhipura/Graupura (wachi) of Nala Ranbi-ara. But the concerned department is silent. Immediate action is requested to be initiated.

4. up-gradation of Government High School into 10+2 Higher Secondary School:-

No doubt the case had been taken up by the Education department in the year 2020-21 But the School was not upgraded.

The education department needs to be educated in the sense that wachi is a huge village having population over 5500 and 3 high schools are running in the village and establishment of a higher secondary in the village is need of the time. Hopeful for revival of the case please.

5. POSTING of ADEQUATE MEDICAL STAFF IN NTPHC WACHI

The NTPHC Wachi has remained closed after the withdrawal of the doctor (Dr. Javid) on deputation since last 3 months. Lack of ambulance facility.

The Government is urged upon to sanction sufficient medical staff for the hospital in order to make it functional round the clock in view of the huge population (above 5500) of the village.

The testing lab. and x-ray plant also needs to be made available please. The ambulance vehicle also needs to be allotted please.
