Major Complaints & Demands

- ① Villagers demand the upgradation of Anant Sarovar which is located in Herseypan Hamlet near (Mambuda) as the spring can cater the whole ^{pure} water problems of the village.
- ② Villagers demand the play ground for students. 103 Kanals of grazing (Govt) land has been identified by the villagers which needs early allocation of funds and tendering.
- ③ Villagers demand immediate upgradation of water scheme which lies in shambles.
- ④ Village demand Relining and Construction of Bunds to Nallah Khehri so that continuous ^{running} pure water supply could remain available to village Bulgom.


