Apart from above, it is Pertinent to mention here that out of Total 42 works, 35 works were Completed and Rest ~~are~~ are in Pipeline.

NOTES

The topography of Kaurai is hilly and it is the last village of Warora Block. The literacy rate of the Population is not conducive. People are not Sensitized to different Schemes Which may uplift them and therefore lack basic amenities. Khidmat Centres which may create awareness of different Schemes beneficial for Public does not exist at all. There is not a single CSC centre which may be the reason for uplifting the economy of the village. Further, the village is without number of govt. offices viz PHC, Patwar Khana, JKB Branch, Sheep and Animal Husbandry, Soil conservation etc. Almost 40% (Forty Percent) of the village has Population that Comes under Schedule Tribe Category. The need of the hour is to declare it as ST village so that

NOTES

The economic Condition of the people could be made better.

Another major Problem which is the root of all other issues is the dilapidate Condition of roads. The roads are not macdemised, the traffic flow is rare, People are suffering to the worst especially in winter Season. Patients fail to reach hospitals even are kept away from first aid centres. The Condition is Pathetic and needs instant redressal on humanitarian grounds. Also, there is basic issue of Portable water. Govt had built a water tanky at the top of village in the lap of forest some 40 years ago. The Condition of the reservoir is crumbling which needs urgent treatment. During rainy Season or just a shower disturbs the Portability of water and dirty water is supplied to the entire village. Supplying Pipes are rusted and are the cause of oiling Condition of the people. Although Previous Plan displays initiative by Govt but still is in vain.

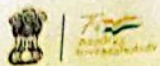

NOTES

1) Major Complaints: (A) It is Pathetic to know that under Sarva Shiksha Mission (SBM) drive, a number of works were executed since 2017 and verified by the concerned officers but till date payments are not drawn, which has created breach of trust.

(B) Eligible beneficiaries under PMAY in 2016-17 were directed to execute their work of building houses, but their second installment is not released to them yet. The beneficiaries staged strong protest in front of under signed.

(C) People who falls under BPL category were intimated to receive free of cost LPG connections. The Agencies collected a minimum of Rs 2000/- and more from the BPL and delivered them cylinders. 70% (approx) quota was delivered and 30% is yet to deliver. Huge amount was collected from Poor Public and no action against the LPG Agencies was taken so far.

2) Major Urgent Public Demand

(A) The Panchayat of Kauri has repeatedly mentioned in almost all Phases of B2V that the topography of the village is different and can not be measured in terms of kilometres - their urge is to establish a Primary Health Centre in the Centre of the village. It is difficult for them to reach their adjacent village for first aid etc. especially during winter. Their genuine demand is nullified for no apparent reason.

(B) Apart from the above, GP demanded the link roads to be made functional with WBM. The dilapidated condition of roads are deplorable and must be addressed at any cost.

(C) Additional Eight (08) Anganwadi Centres to be sanctioned to different wards on Per Population Ratio.
