② Overall assessment of the visit & suggestions

During my visit as visiting officer in Panchayat Bathoire-A and I found that lower staff was being deputed as front line worker in B2V4 by every deptt. which resulted in not getting data exactly and the local people and also the PR3 members were not well aware about the different schemes of departments.

Suggestions:- In such programmes, higher rank officer of every department should be deputed, so that people are made aware about the schemes of the deptt. and this will make easy to get exact data at the ground level.

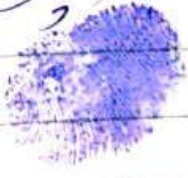
