Overall Assessment of the Panchayat Sungal Lower-C

The PRI members including Sarpanch are very serious for the resolution of the issues of the people and they are working very hard by raising the same at the appropriate level. The water supply, is -totally piped water supplied by PHE Deptt. (Now Jal Shakti Deptt.) is regularly executed but the leakage issues are still there and there is serious issue of no piped/tap water supply to Water Ward No 7. The physical connectivity of the village is good but the roads need blacktopping. The PHC located in the village takes good care of the people's health at the primary level but its upgradation by way of addition of X-Ray Machine needs to be supplemented by the appointment of X-Ray Technician and the maintenance of already existing Staff Quarters. The Govt and Private schools located in the Panchayat cater to the educational needs of the children of the residents. But the toilets/washrooms particularly at Govt High School Sungal need urgent attention and renovation, rather a new ESC is required as the existing washrooms are insufficient for catering to the needs of the students. The Badminton and Basketball Courts need to be developed. The library and laboratories need upgradation. The old building needs urgent repair and renovation. The schemes like PMAY, SBM-G, have well covered the people but there are still issues as the needy people have not been covered under 2011 census and subsequent surveys. The people complain regarding the Revenue Department ^{Survey} as the same is not that responsive to the needs of the people like Girdwaris, Pans, Tutkal, Land Possession, etc. Sufficient number of people have been covered under ~~Golden~~ ^{Golden} ~~la~~ ^{la} Ayushman Bharat Scheme, Janani Suraksha Yojana. There is lack of awareness of Govt Digital Schemes & Services. The Community Service Centre needs to be activated for the same. Digital Literacy campaign need to be seriously launched in the Panchayat for the PRI members and the people at large. The various Govt department catering to the needs of the people of Halga Panchayat Sungal Lower-C lack co-ordination and before start of any project/planning the concerned departments need to co-ordinate so that the people don't face problem during the execution of the projects. The Youth here directly require skill development for self, as well as other employment in other sectors too. The women folk too need skill development for self-employment in the village itself. The Playground need to be developed further for the involvement of the youth in sports and games. The Gram Sabhas need to be held frequently for the increased involvement of the people in the implementation of the schemes. The projects/plans prepared during B2V Programmes need to be implemented ~~for~~ ^{so} that the people seriously involve themselves in the same. ^{immediately} (This has been the observation of the people in Panchayat)
