I. There were three major complaints:-

- (i) Acute scarcity of drinking water. pipes have been installed, but no water supply.
- (ii) PHC needs to be shifted from Panchayat ghar to the newly constructed building at Check-post.
- (iii) New grid station needs to be made functional. It just needs nine poles to make it functional.

II. The major public demands besides the mentioned above are:-

- (i) Lanes, drains and inner paths and bunds of the villages have not been upgraded.
- (ii) People demand electric poles and wires as the old ones have been damaged.

III There is dire need of upgrading and constructing lanes, drains and paths. Schools need more toilets especially for girl students. Besides, there should be a children's park. The problems faced by the Agamvani workers need to be resolved. Fencing of Id-gah near Janic-masjid. The government has done a lot, still more needs to be done.
