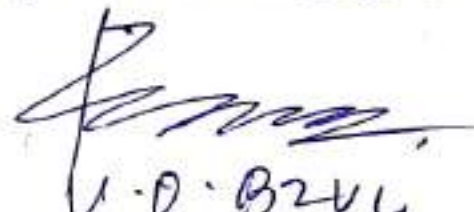

Demands and Requisitions:-

- General Public:-
- (1) upgradation of M/S school as a high school.
 - (2) Panchayat halqa Charangam should be put into Back ward Category, because of Social, Political, educational and economic backwardness.
 - (3) Construction of road from the house of Ab. Kasim Das to the Aslan Sharief.
 - (4) Demand for Nayabat and repairment of Panchayat Ghar.
 - (5) Demand for Sukhraj water supply scheme.
 - (6) Demand for the change of Transformer along with line which has been sanctioned by the P.D.D. but till date the Transformer situated in the back^{side} of the house of Ali Moud^{Sheikh}. It needs special attention from the P.D.D. deptt. so that people may be benefitted. Due to some misunderstanding of the people and the deptt. still transformer is not in function. It needs special attention.

Demands and Requisitions:-

Schools:- ii, M/S Chasangam:- All the people demanded for the up gradation of the said institution. It is the burning demand of the people.

P/S Chasangam:- i, There are cracks in the walls of the school building which is totally unsafe for educational purposes.

ii, One of most important demand of the teaching staff and the parents is that there is an H.T. line passing through/on the premises of the school which is a big and great danger for small kids. In this regard P.D.D. is requested to change the line from the premises of the school as per the demands and fears of the parents.

M/S Selam Mohallah:- i, problem of Electricity.

ii, problem of road iii, problem of having wall nuts in the premises of the school which are dangerous in form of the damaging of school building as well as for the precious lives of students during the time of fast wind and snow.

Demands and requisitions:-

- ① Health Care Centre:- i, In sufficient infrastructure in the Centre. ii, NO Wash room iii, Demand for Composite PH for waste. iv, Medical Assistant Post. v, Govt. Building.
- ② ICDS (Anganwadi Centers):- i, NO infrastructure like chairs, Tables, bench etc. (There was not a single chair in the centre). In this regard Social welfare dept. is requested to provide basic infrastructure to the concerned Centers.
- ③ Schools:- i, M/S Charangam: Tremendous road problem as the school building is very down and the main road is very high and the link goes to School is totally unsafe and very dangerous. In this regard special attention of PWD or Block development's office needs to solve this problem. The small kids and all students suffer during rains and snow because of the unsafe road.
- ii, Incomplete walling need to be completed.
- iii, No main gate for the School having 100+ Roll.
- iv, Only one wash room for 100+ staff.
- v, There is a damaged building which needs to be auctioned.

Grievances

- ① 3rd instalment of kisan funds not ~~be~~ paid to so many households.
- ② C.D. Fund of Rs. 2300000/2 (Twenty three lacs) sanctioned for the Panchayat halqa for the Tube-well water but due to some departmental issues fund has not been utilized for the common people.
- ③ Receiving Station has been sanctioned by the deptt. of P.O.D. to the Panchayat halqa Charanjam but the Revenue deptt. is not providing the land to the concerned deptt. while as the halqa village Charanjam has donated land for it.

Receiving Station has been sanctioned vide sub-Transmission division Rajbager's order NO:- STD II 2853-57/75 dt. 20-09-2022.

- ④ One of the household of the said halqa namely Ab. Ahad Dar s/o Ab. Rahim Dar has an agricultural land and P.O.D. deptt. is running an H.T. Line from the middle of his land. He wants to change the line and wants to keep the line in a one side of his land. So that he may cultivate his land without any problem. The P line passing from the middle/center of his land creates a great problem to him. Hence P.O.D. is requested to solve his problem if possible.
- ⑤ In-sufficient staff in Jk Bank Ulligam as the Panchayat halqa Charanjam has no other bank except Jk Bank Chelligam Branch. (30)
