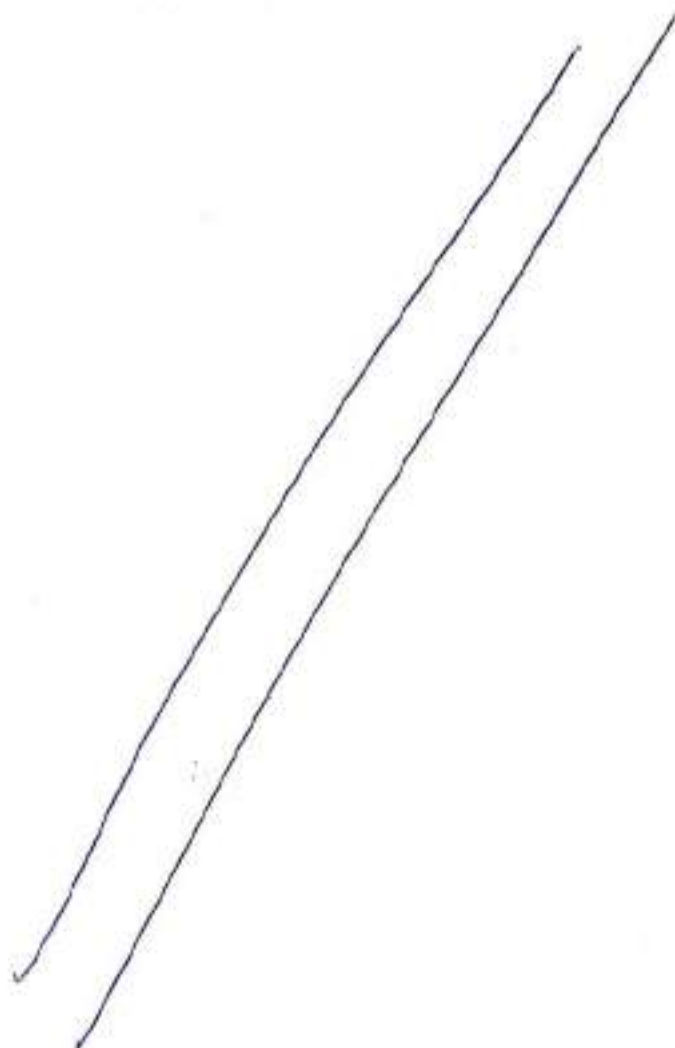

I. MAJOR COMPLAINTS BROUGHT TO THE NOTICE OF VISITING OFFICER

- (i) Performance data/requirements/demands have been taken in previous B2V programs but on the whole things have not changed much. Critical demands left out which has made people uninterested & participation was poor.
- (ii) Several people raised issue of clean drinking water. Though situation has improved slightly, several people are dependent on water from Spring/brook.
- (iii) Most interior lanes/pathways are in shambles with patchy work of lanes/drain & concrete.
- (iv) Lack of stress on welfare of youth/children/employment generation. Non availability of playfield/recreational facilities. School infrastructure is poor.
- (v) Certain areas/mohallas of village feel left out/neglected in allocation of works.
- (vi) The cleanliness of village is a huge concern with garbage lying in lanes/drains/inside garden/ground/road side. No provision of garbage/waste segregation & disposal.
- (vii) The transporters from Nagam (Sumo Service) don't stick to their agreed fare & cause inconvenience to passengers of Panchayat.
- (viii) The middle school (which is actually a merged school) has several problems which have been repeatedly highlighted earlier also but no action taken. Incomplete building, presence of walnut trees, lack of fencing, unlevelled ground, lack of water & sanitation.
- (ix) Panchayat Lhar needs improvement. Windows/glass panes missing. No toilet/water supply. No Chowkidar/numberdar allotted.
- (x) No provision or availability of veterinary point.
- (xi) Ayush & Health welfare centre inadequately housed. Health Centre is located in Aripantam-B.
- (xii) Aadhar Creation facility not available in CSC.



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II MAJOR / URGENT DEMANDS

- i) Clean drinking tap water to be provided to entire population. Existing JTM schemes to be expedited. This needs Top most priority.
- ii) Identification of land for waste shed & its development. Dust bins/containers to be provided & mechanism for removal of such waste to be developed.
- iii) Development of playground, properly leveled & fenced. Land already identified.
- iv) Shifting of Health & Wellness centre which is currently operating from a very poor & dilapidated building.
- v) Land allocation & development of Ayush Wellness centre. To be shifted from existing rented building with poor infrastructure.
- vi) Middle school needs leveling of ground, completion of half constructed building (which is getting damaged due to neglect), removal of walnut trees & fencing of boundary.
- vii) Lanes / pathways / bund strengthening :-
 - (a) House of Asad-ul-Pandith to Sh. Mehd Pandith
 - (b) Front side of Sheikh Mohalla connecting main road. Has open drain.
 - (c) Improvement / R-walling of Ziyat Sharif Link Road.
 - (d) R-wall / Bund strengthening of Matar Mohalla.
 - (e) Asthan Road to house of Ab. Hamid Wani
- viii) Infrastructure upgrading of Panchayat Lhar & appointment of Chowkidar / Numberdar.
- ix) Construction of Aboora Road to House of Gh. Ahmad Khan. (Link road improvement).

III OVERALL ASSESSMENT OF VISIT AND SUGGESTIONS

It was felt that the overall functioning & involvement of people was less primarily due to the fact that the most pressing demands of people have been repeatedly highlighted in B2V1, B2V2 & B2V3. People have a perception that very little has been achieved & some of the most critical demands have been left unaddressed. The demands have been repeated. Though line departments like PHE, Health, Education are doing what is possible within their constraints the most pressing demands have remained for one reason or the other which are summarized below:-

- (i) Clean tapped drinking water. Not entire village gets it. This needs to be expedited with JTM schemes.
- (ii) The entire UP is full of garbage spread all over. Plastic, waste, paper, etc is lying on roads, schools, Panchayat lihar, bylanes, play ground (partially developed). Panchayat body should wake up to this on priority & take advantage of programs like B2V4.
- (iii) Bylanes / drains are partially developed & at most places is unmacadamized/unfiled with potholes & over flowing drains. Concerned line departments to be made aware & source of fundis identified.
- (iv) The children / youth of the UP are mostly neglected. With one school which is for last several years subject to neglect has several problems highlighted already. Whatever is possible with minimal fundis like cutting of walnut trees should be undertaken.
- (v) Functioning of Panchayat is below par. With poor infrastructure & quorum of only 3 members, less interest in SHGs, Youth clubs, etc is noticed.
- (vi) ICDS / Health department is doing a good job & should be appreciated. Also job of CSC was observed to be good.

Most humbly and respectfully the undersigned would like to inform you that Govt. MS Kandhama is facing a number of problems. The main problems are mentioned below:

1. Some years ago a new three room building was constructed under SSA but it was left half-way without windows, doors and above all a roof. The said building needs immediate construction as the school is facing accommodation problems. Sometimes the classes have to be taken in the open.

② There are a number of walnut trees in the ground. They pose a threat to the existing buildings. Besides, they make the school a shady place and during autumn add to pollution due to the falling of leaves. These walnut trees need to be cut immediately.

③ The school has a fencing, but it needs immediate repairment as it is broken at many places. Some part of the ground is still without a fence. So fencing is also posing a threat.

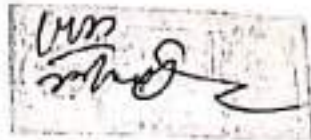
