### (I) Major Complaint/DEMANDS:


- The Panchayat Halga is in need of a Gram Panchayat Building which needs to be constructed on Priority Basis.

- The Primary as well as Middle School has insufficient infrastructure. There is a need of providing additional rooms to both the schools.
- There is a dire need of separate toilets for boys and girls for the school. Also computer labs may be installed for the benefit of students.
- The People demands a Playground & upgradation of the School to the level of High School

- The Health Sub-centre is in need of regular Power supply, garbage pit and a Sweeper.
  - Due to the increase in the child population Ward-II needs a ICDS centre.
  - The Aanchal colony & Ahangar ~~Hall~~ Mohalla Changan needs installation of LT Poles/wires and drinking water supply for Aanchal Colony Changan.
