was quite surprised that almost 90% of the work on the building is completed in 2007-08 only but due to some minor issues the two-storey building is languishing since then. The story doesn't end here; the languishing building is now getting looted by thieves and has become the hub for various social evils. There is a need to take this issue on priority to stop any further damage to the building in particular and public in general.

To my astonishment there are other projects which have met more or less the same fate. Among them CSC centre, Community Hall, Shopping Complex are few worthy mentions. It hurts to see that more than a crore has been spent on these projects with zero outcomes when they all are only one final push away.

2. From B2V phase-I people of *Dangerpora-A* are demanding for a JK BANK branch with ATM facility.
3. Proper implementation of PHE schemes to curd shortage of water supply.
4. Land settlement must be done ASAP.

Overall Assessment:

Overall functioning of the Panchayat is satisfactory however there are certain areas which require improvement. Elected PRIs are not aware about their role and functions. There is also lack of coordination between PRIs. Periodic gatherings in presence of BDC and other officials may help.

BACK TO VILLAGE- PHASE IV

General Assessment of the Visiting Officer

PH: Dangerpora A

Block: Zaingeer

District: Baramulla

Major Complaints:

1. Local Contractors complained that their payments are pending even after getting a nod from the technical supervisory team. According to them after the completion of the work, their work is supervised by non-Technical officials who declare their work below par which is completely unfair.

Another group of contractors complained about delegated authority. According to them some contractors after getting a particular contract delegates it to another contractor at a fixed cut. Who, in turn, delegates it further creating a chain leading to the snowballing of the total work cost. This increases the burden on the contractor who eventually completes the work forcing him/her to resort to sub-standard material in order to maintain profit margin.

2. Most people complained about the functioning of PHE department. According to them water supply in our area is very thin, many water pipes are broken and many schemes (JJM) are not properly implemented in our area.
3. Fencing of HSS Dangerpora completed during phase II of B2V isn't tall enough to guard against any infiltration.

Major /Urgent Public Demands that was/were reflected earlier but not have been addressed so far:

1. During my 2-day stay if there was something which created huge public outcry is the Languishing PHC building. On inspection I
