The major complaints brought into the notice of visiting officer:

1. PMAY-g: A number of beneficiaries complained that their due payments are pending and they are unable to complete construction of their units. As winter is approaching fast, the due installments need to be released as these beneficiaries are currently living in tin sheds
2. Golden card are being issued at a very slow pace: The Department of Health needs to be directed to achieve 100 percent saturation within a short span of time so that the poor and needy beneficiaries can take advantage of the scheme
3. Re-verification of Ration cards: A number of beneficiaries complained that they have been wrongly included in APL Category while as their income is very low . The process needs to be completed immediately.
4. Absence of playing field in panchayat: The panchayat lacks proper infrastructure for sports and development of sports facilities will help in channelizing the energy of youth in positive manner.
5. Absence of safe drinking water: A number of residents particularly from Ganie mohalla , maidani mohalla, Shiekh Mohalla reported that they had to cover long distances to get drinking water. Some temporary arrangements need to be put in place till JJM schemes are fully implemented.
6. Water logging: A number of residents particularly from Ganie Mohalla and Yarbali Mohalla also complained regarding water logging in their areas causing them severe inconvenience.
7. A complaint was brought into the notice wherein a family was denied marriage assistance by Social Welfare Department.

Major urgent demands that were reflected earlier but have not been addressed so far:

1. Power transmission network: The wires and poles are in shambles. Raw wooden logs or trees are instead used for transmission. The damaged electric lines are seen everywhere with very low thickness. The demand for their replacement has been repeatedly raised during earlier Back to village programs. ( Action by PDD)
2. Inadequate infrastructure in the schools: The demand has been raised earlier also but hasn't been resolved so far. The school has limited classrooms which need renovation immediately as winter is approaching. Further the civic amenities like toilet and water facility also needs renovation. The electricity to the existing buildings also needs restoration and repairs. ( Action by School Education Department.)
3. Absence of playfields: The development of playgrounds in the panchayat has not been taken up thus far which is a major requirement for channelizing the energy of the youth.( Action by RDD)



4. NTPHC building which had been left incomplete by R&B needs to be completed immediately and dedicated to the general public. Further current staffing as well as equipments of the PHC is inadequate which needs to be looked into. ( Action by R&B, RDD, Health)
5. Repairs and construction of protection walls on the banks. Being flood prone area, the protection bunds need to be put in place. ( action by Irrigation and flood control)
6. The Animal Husbandry Department needs separate Building of its own as majority of the residents depend on livestock and agriculture.

**Overall Assessment:**

1. As predominantly agriculture and livestock are primary sources of income, the schemes regarding farm welfare by various departments need to be popularized by concerned departments as there was little awareness regarding these schemes among general masses.
2. The panchayat being Flood affected during 2014 floods,needs much attention in terms of the public infrastructure like development of pavements, lanes, school and health infrastructure .
3. RDD should focus more on SBM particularly sanitation of the village.
