General Assessment

Panchayat Mahore - B is located in a very hilly terrain where it is difficult to connect every village through Road works. GRIF has undertaken the construction of two lane Road from Reasi to Mahore. The work is slow as it has been started in the year 2004 and still lot of work is to be completed. Due to non completion of the Road smooth traffic movement is not possible. Moreover efforts for construction of internal Roads need to be taken. Health Centers in the shape of primary Sub Centers in the Panchayat is recommended along with one high school. The Government staff is not sufficient to cater all the Panchayat presently as villages are located faraway.


