- a) Major portion of Panchayat has poor network connectivity that leads to difficulties in communication particularly students.
- b) Illegal mining continues unabated in the Panchayat
- c) The rivers & irrigation canals need immediate attention as major population is dependent on agriculture.

3. Overall assessment of visit and suggestions

The Panchayat body is weak and some Panchs are not attending programmes regularly leading to burdening of Sarpanch & remaining Panchs. The absent Panchs shall be held accountable. The people are satisfied with the work of government. All the departments are performing well but staff deficiency remains an issue. People are happy with the initiative of Govt. like Nasha Mukht Bhaut, Green & clean village & these programmes need regular follow up.
