

A Ration Ghat, a Health Center, an Animal Husbandary & a Common Services Center in the area. Moreover, additional trans_ formers (at least three) need to be installed. Filtration plant needs to be made functional & supply lines need repair.

Overall, functioning of various schemes Department needs improvement in the panchayat. Moreover, the PRI representatives need to improve their work & involve more efficiently in public works.
