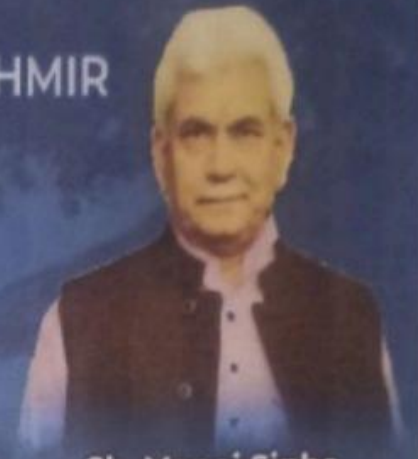

GENERAL ASSESSMENT OF THE VISTING OFFICER

I	Any major complaint brought to the notice of the Visiting Officer: 1. The condition of PDD network is very bad and the concerned department is least bothered. 2. Shortage of staff in Govt HSS Malanau and PHE Malanau.
