



- He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any com-
- While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and rewhile preparing village developments, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to adminitractive deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
- His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
