②<sup>B</sup> GMS Chattergul Rajeev (Panchayat Nalga Chattergul - B)

The School has only three rooms for 180 students. The Deptt. has provided kindergarten facility in which 35 students are enrolled but Mother for them is not posted yet.

③ The Govt. Middle School Bampur Chattergul is presently functioning in 2 buildings leaving five (5) rooms. A piece of land measuring about 5 Kanals<sup>2</sup> provided by the Panchayat body. The land is however uneven & needs levelling.




