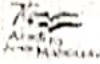

Overall Assessment

- The Panchayat has improved from last B2V but still there is more more to do.
- The Educational Institutions has infrastructure but insufficient for the demand
- Panchayat body is not working properly as 02 out of 05 panchs were absent namely Sonallah Rathur & Mubeena Begum of ward No. 05 & 07 respectively.
- There is lack of coordination between departments like PHE & R & B as the piping by PHE has been done after sorting & metalling by R & B.
- There are many complaints against the contractors who was involved in laying of water pipes by general public & panchayat body.
- There was very poor participation of public in gram-sabha.
- The Anganwadi Centre are in debilitated conditions & the workers of AWCs are facing many issues like delayed payments, etc.
