

## **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

1. The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on [www.jkpanchayat.in](http://www.jkpanchayat.in) portal, before they leave panchayat.
7. Focus of visit are youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukt, bhrashtrachar mukt, Rozgar yukt J&K, besides to carry forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and saturate them.
8. In addition attention may be given to the following areas





## Overall assessment of the visit and suggestions:

The visit to the Panchayat was very fruitful and satisfactory. The Sarpanch and the PRI members were very supportive and cooperative. Govt officers/officials assigned to the Panchayat for Back to village programme were also supportive and have displayed the stalls and made the public aware of the various schemes run by the respective Departments. Some of the major issues which brought to the notice are:

- 1) There is no Khidmat Centre in the Panchayat. People have to go to Tatwali/Ghagwal. In this connection Sarpanch was asked to identify some youth who can avail the benefit and loan from JK Bank to start Khidmat centre.
- 2) Some people raise the issue that they are deserving and eligible beneficiaries for PMAY Houses, but have been rejected. In this connection Sarpanch and PRI members was asked to identify, verify and pass the resolution and submit the list of such beneficiaries to Block Development officer Ghagwal for consideration.
