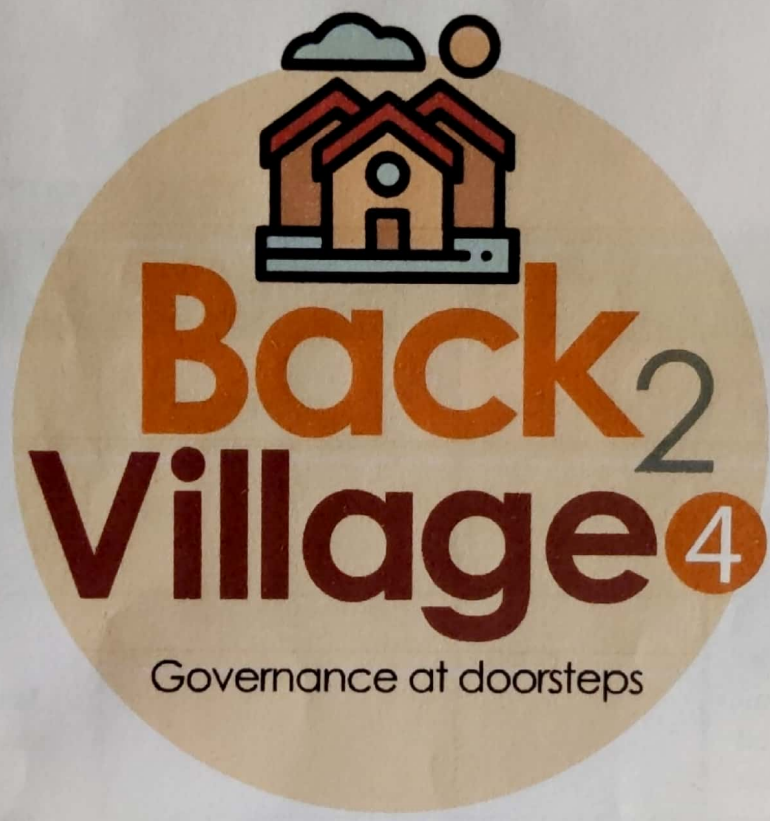

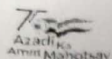

The gram panchayat - Balhama has 7 Panchs, ~~at~~ however, the post of Sarpanch is lying vacant. The Panch body along with the RDD staff is recognizing the problems faced by the general masses and are trying hard for overall redressal of all the demands. The people are satisfied with the road connectivity being developed over the years in the area. The education dept. also seems performing well but the infrastructure of schools needs further upgradation. - ④ Banking sector needs to establish more branches in the area along with the installation of ATM, locally. This can make financial transactions easy and effortless for the locals.
- ⑤ School ground and local playgrounds need to be upgraded so that children and local youth can participate in outdoor sports activities and can also highlight/showcase their talent in the field of sports.
