## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on [www.jkpanchayat.in](http://www.jkpanchayat.in) portal, before they leave panchayat.

### OVER ALL ASSESMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER AND SUGGESTIONS

The panchayat is situated on a hilly terrain having insufficient vegetation, meager sources of income and employment. Despite the fact that state govt. has opened schools in every hamlet of the panchayat ranging from primary to middle to High school but the overall literacy rate looks dismal. As of now, around 460 students are enrolled in the schools and is a good sign but the dropout rate is scary one. Travelling across the length and breadth of panchayat, less than 1% of students were identified who had reached to a college or university level. The area has a good human capital which needs to be channelized besides a tremendous potential for tourism and if developed can open the sources of employment for the local population in particular and district in general. There is an urgent need of incorporating skills training among the indigenous population for which various skill centers should be opened there. Overall, the panchayat has developed and progressed over the years but much needs to be done. Last but not least availability of Ambulance in the panchayat is an urgent requirement.
