- ① Road :- It was quite amazing found in this era of development, they (people) are still very far away from road and one has to travel 90' from the river to the village with more than 2000 (approx) of population is facing hardship.
- ② School - Two schools namely GPS Dharu and GPS Kandulhar are running in private building and the condition of building is more than worst, water, snakes and many insects you can observe inside the school premises. which is always a life threat to the children and teachers of the said schools.
- ③ Health centre :- As already mentioned about the situation of panchayat and mothers have to travel large distance, carrying their load on back, for medical check up. Hence either provide health centre or routine check up at least in a month.
- ④ Upgradation of school :- approximately 170 students are there in GPS school and after that most of the students left their studies post primary grade.

Students as the nearest approachable schools are ^{at distance of} ~~the~~ more - than 2 hours ~~by~~ by foot and hence violating RTE of Students. also lack of staff is there and ~~not~~ ^{there} no one to teach.

Hence violation of RTE and should be given due consideration and the action should be taken against the culprits.
