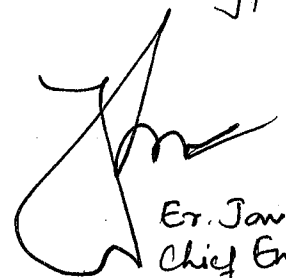

Overall assessment / Suggestions.

During Current Session of the B2V, primarily it has been observed that public participation has improved as compared with last B2V programme. Interests of Citizens of Panchet village Ashram in local governance are building day by day. Involvement of Stake holders in the process of development has opened many avenues unexplored in the journey of development of village.
