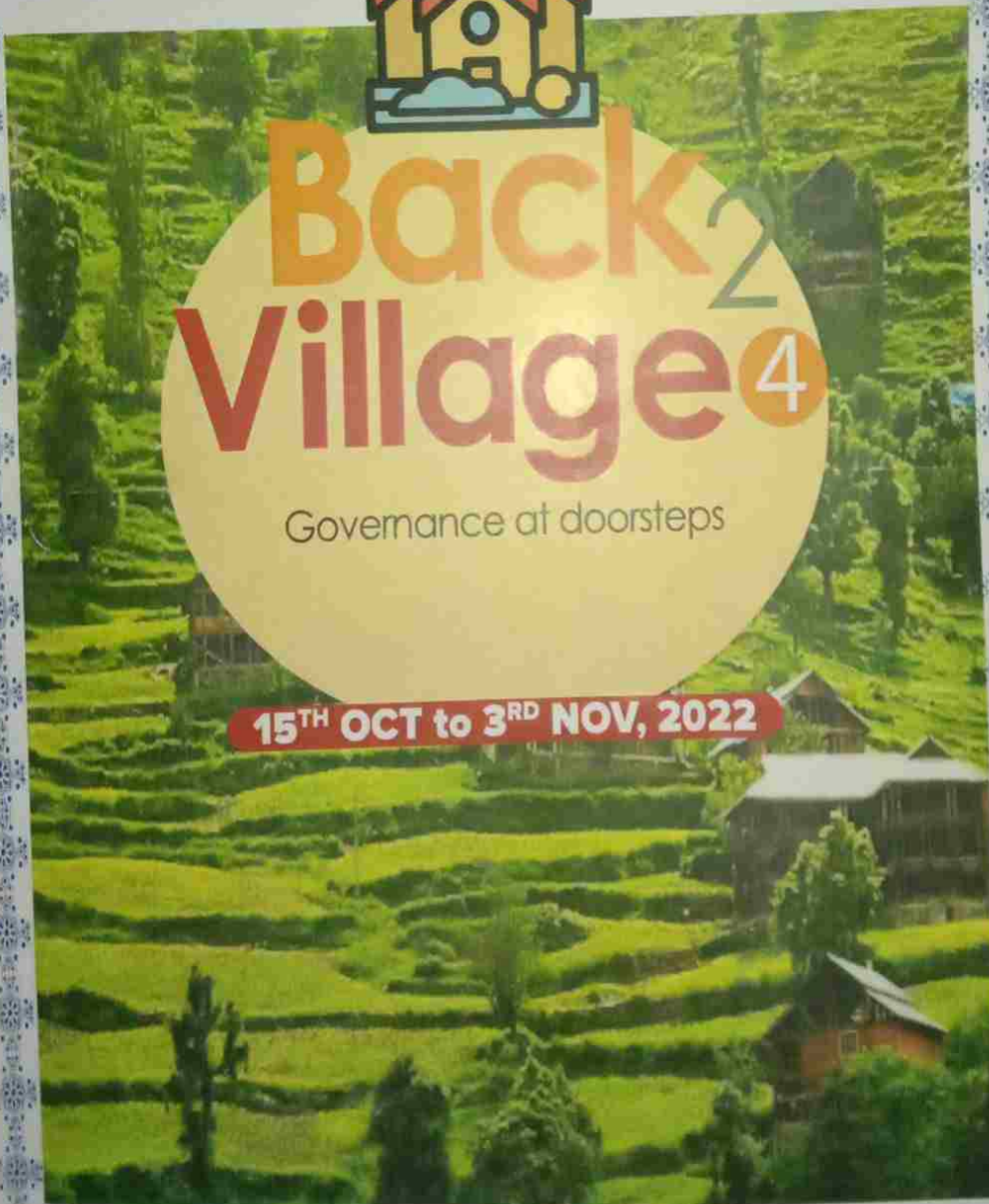

- ## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS
- The visiting officers must refrain from directly going to offering any government and state aid, adopt an indifferent attitude in regarding business development through the bonded unit, a fair and unbiased view envisaging village.

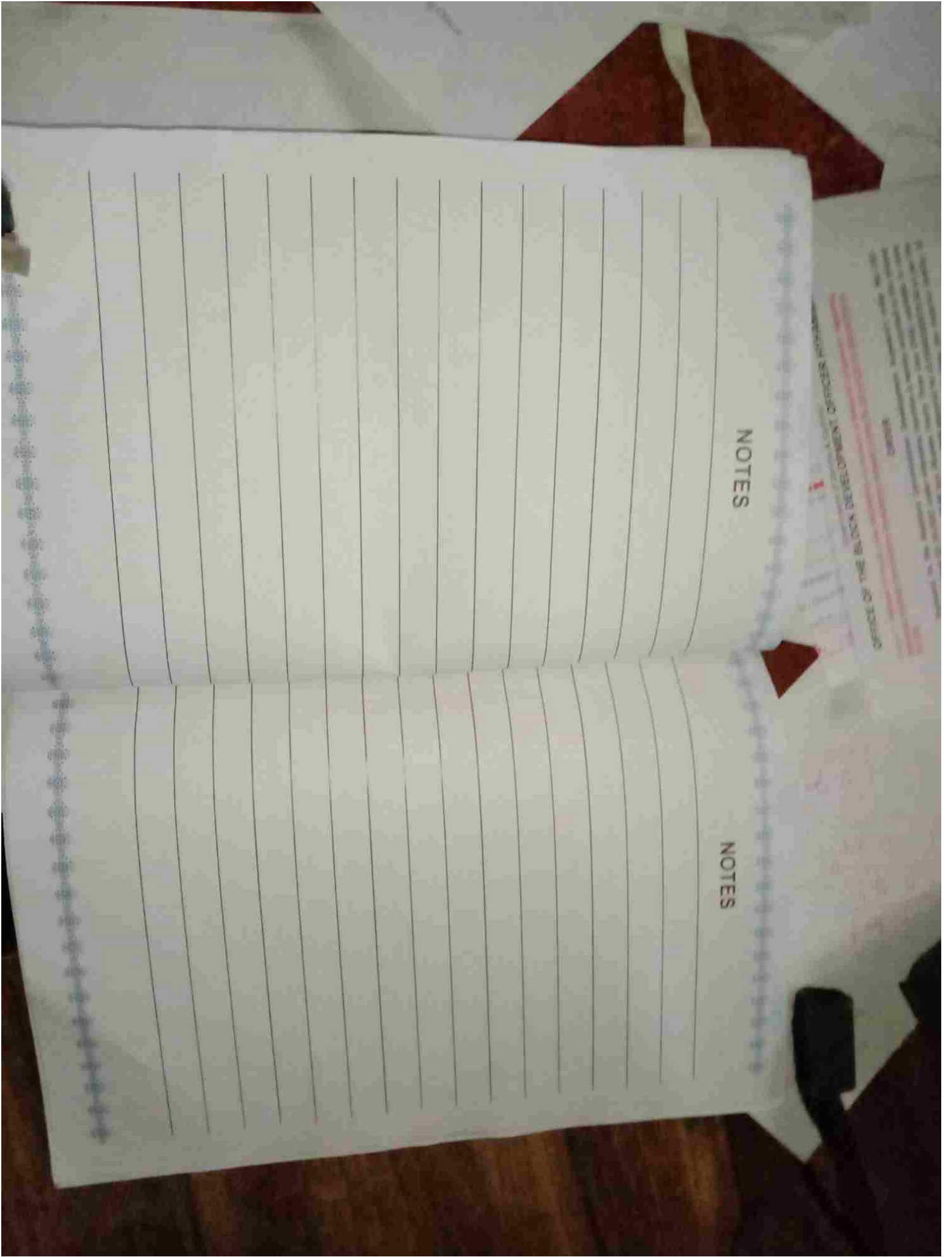
