All houses are electrified. Anganwadi and health and wellness centre is functioning properly. People are benefiting from different schemes like PMEGP, disability and widow pension, Golden cards and ration cards are being updated and issued. Land passbooks are generated and shall soon be issued. \n Khidmat centre is located adjacent to JK bank branch Ratnipora and is not functional. Same needs to be shifted to Dangam village. More works need to be done under PMAY and SBMG. Govt Schools of the Panchayat Halqa have been clubbed with another School of village Wangam and the buildings remain unutilized and are getting deteriorated, same need to be allotted to health department. The PH has neither a playground nor a childrens park. Three more Anganwadi centres are needed to make small children convenient to attend. As the PH is dependent on horticulture the concerned departments needs to issue necessary equipments in sufficient numbers(few have been issued). |
