- Need PHE Pipe line connection in wards 1,3,5,6 of Panchayat as there is no PHE supply in all wards. Required Back to village of all roads in Panchayat.
- Back to village of Road from Atirum link Road to Nangal village Gurjara Basti.
- Overall assessment is satisfactory but need improvement by PHE, PWD, and PDS
