No major complaints however people want government to fulfill their ~~ma~~ demands reflected during previous phases of B2V.

Anganwari workers/helpers demand their pending salary for the last one year. They also complain non-availability of drinking water facilities for their centres.

(II) Major/Urgent public demands

① As the area is hilly, a good number of protection bunds are needed to protect houses/lanes. Such spots may be identified and done on priority. One such P/bund is immediately required near the house of Ab Ahad Sofi.

② As most of the population reside in upper Arwah. This area has very very poor water supply. An effective water supply scheme may be sanctioned for upper area.

③ Replacement of damaged pipeline from Beerwah to Arwah.

④ Play ground for Arwah.

⑤ Macadamization of road from Arwah to Ichiham.

⑥ Fencing & P/bund for grave yard.

⑦ Electric poles & wire for the remaining area.

⑧ New wire for H/T line.

⑨ 12 concrete drains  at various places.

(III) Overall assessment of visit

Major population of Arwah is poor. They lack awareness of govt. schemes. The inner village lacks cleanliness. Some people still use old traditional latrines. Cowdung can be seen collected near their houses. The inner connecting lanes are very narrow.

Special team of experts may be sent to the village for making people aware of govt. schemes and motivate them. Biogas plants may be established. There is scope for dairy farm/sheep farm. One or two inner lanes may be widened. The village needs to be adopted specially. The govt. school in Arwah may be given special attention for improving the basic education in Arwah.
