


GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
- He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
- 3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
- 4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
- 5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
- Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.
- 7. Focus of visit are youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukt, bhrashtrachar mukt, Rozgar yukt J&K, besides to carry forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and saturate them.
- 8. In addition attention may be given to the following areas

Overall Assessment of the Visit and Suggestions.

The Panchayat is just 2 Kms from the Head quarter Reasi. The issues of water scarcity and electricity came up during the first day of proceedings. The people of the panchayat were of the view that the there is problem of low water supply which gets aggravated further when the inhabitants use motors directly with the supply lines. The J.E. PHE – Jal shakti informed about the new project under JJM for the Panchayat. Till the time this project is functional, it was suggested that the power supply during the water supply timings should be switched off so that the people of the area are not able to use motors during that slot. Further the issue related to distribution of electric load by way of installation of more transformers came up during the interaction with people of Panchayats. The same are required to be addressed on priority. It was highlighted by the people that there is an urgent need of a Play Ground and community hall in the Panchayat. The land identification is required for Play Ground and Community hall. It is observed in general that the inhabitants of the area are aware of the Govt. schemes and are taking benefit also of the same.

Repair and Renovation of the only School , in the Panchayat is urgently required.

Two houses under PMAY were sanctioned which have been completed up to plinth level with the first instalment received. No funds after that have been received for the completion of these houses. Some more poor deserving people of Panchayat are interested to apply for construction of houses under PMAY.


