

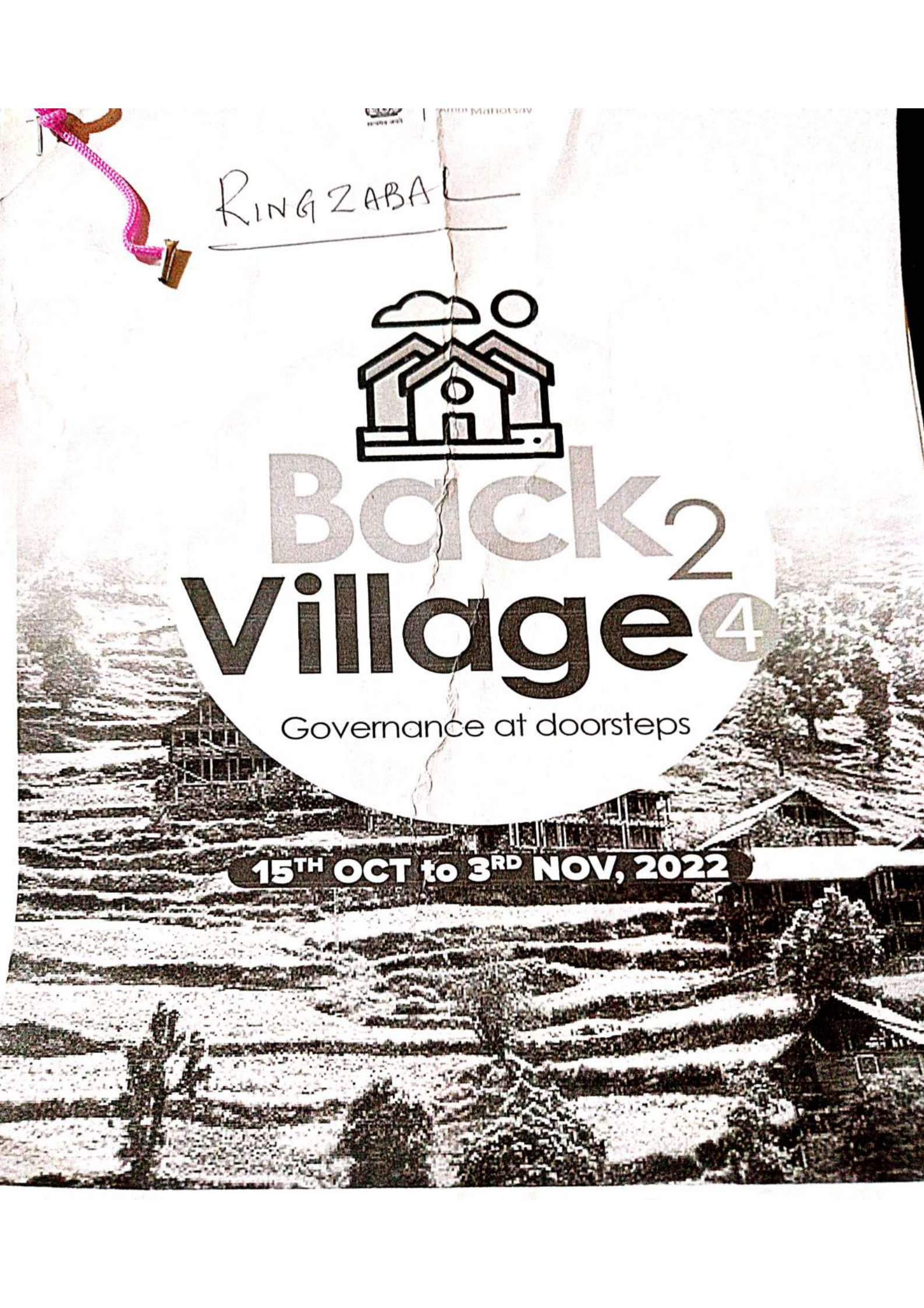

Besides this panchayat has a scope of rural tourism in the form of Nallah Sukhnag and landscapes for trekking and view points. This will boost the standard of living of the people and will generate self employment among the people of said village.
