

# Major / Urgent Public Demands

## 1. Lack of portable tap water / Drinking water.

- (a) The six decade old water pipes must be replaced from Shiva to Durroo, & water filtration plant must be made fully functional.
- (b) The court stay of water filtration plant at Taulia Khan Mundayi must be vacated, and made functional asap as it can cater Mundayi, Durroo & Dargapur together.
- (c) Alternate water scheme should be sanctioned from well to Durroo.
- (d) Tap water connection should be given to all the left out houses.

## 2. Demand of better facilities at PHC Durroo.

- (a) establishment of X-ray plant, USG, and other testing equipments.
- (b) Construction of separate wards with bathroom facility.
- (c) Out of 20 sanctioned staff, ~~only~~ 10 posts are vacant. They must be filled asap so that PHC will work satisfactorily.
- (d) Sanction of one ambulance.

## 3. Upgradation & Macadamisation of roads.

- (a) An old age road (constructed in 1960) connecting Durroo with Wazirpur is in dilapidated condition. It must be macadamised on priority basis owing to its social & economic importance for these hamlets.
- (b) Macadamisation of all inner lanes of Durroo 'A'.

## 4. Up gradation required in power sector

- (a) Installation of new electric poles, wires in entire panchayat.
- (b) Installation of 100KV transformers & wires at Masjid Ibrahim Townhead colony and at the periphery of pul mshulla. <sup>Rather</sup> ~~rather~~ mshulla.
- (c) There are 3HT/1LT wires ~~are~~ <sup>are</sup> together from Hospital to pectri pectri. ~~Either~~ threat to commuters. Either cable wiring or large poles with adequate safety margins should be used.
- (d) Installation of street solar lights.

- ## 5. Establishment of J&K Bank Branch, Model CSC, ATM branch, fire service station, Nayabud gar, forest depo & agriculture sub centre.
- Complete embankment of Zairpur canal and its desiltation including its sublets asap.

- (d) Picking up zanger canal to tangbag.

- (d) Drainage system in Mohalla Peer/Mir at Durro.

8. Upgradation of roads (MREGA)

## Over All Assessment

The most of the departments work independently without co-ordinating with other departments thereby leading to mismanagement. Lack of co-ordination among deptl need to be addressed. There is a lack of awareness among the masses about different govt initiatives/schemes.

The most of the public requirements/Demands or grievances were highlighted in all the three B2V programmes. But 90% of these demands or grievances were not redressed till date due to which the people showed cold response to B2V4.

## Suggestions

1. The grievances highlighted by people in all the 4 back to village programmes should be addressed asap. Next back to village programme should be conducted once around 60% of Demands highlighted in B2V(1 to 4) are redressed.
2. There should be a strict quality check of every developmental work.
3. There should not be any delay in release of funds & every developmental work must be time bound.
4. There should be enhancement in fund allocation at ~~each~~ Panchayat level.
5. For mass awareness, <sup>about schemes</sup> all departments should use different social media.
6. Sufficient staff must be provided to all govt departments.
