## - B2V4

- ① For PHC the fencing of the building is highly needed as per the demands of the people near one the pond may be renovated which is falling in the premises of PHC. The people demands roads and in FRAPSU.
- ② As per Mahajana Scheme the land near available before the land is available Pithapuram plant is highly demanded at an early date. Near one Kochapur Gauri colony, Para Michalle, Tali Michalle needs water pipes.
