- 3. Insufficient, inconvenient and unsuitable accommodation of Govt. Middle School, Sholipora 'B' ; needs shift from that place.
- 4. Non-availability of dumping site for waste/unused materials

### **II. Major/Urgent Public demands that was/were reflected earlier but have not been addressed sofar:**

1. Upgradation of Playground.
2. Non-availability of desired Anganwadi centres.
3. Non- Availability of electric poles (HT as well as LT) with conductors.
4. People are complaining about erratic supply of electricity especially during winter season.
5. Regarding PHC, people were complaining about non-availibility of Lab Technician, night stay of Doctors and non-availability of Equipments like USG machine, X-Ray machine, Biochemistry Analyzer etc.
6. People were also complaining about curtailment of ration from 10kg/head to 5kg/head by Food and Supplies Department.
