## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.

He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.

While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans

His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.

Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.

Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on [www.jkpanchayat.in](http://www.jkpanchayat.in) portal, before they leave panchayat.

Focus of visit are youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukt, bhrashtachar mukt, Rozgar yukt J&K, besides to carry forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and saturate them.

8. There is great potential of **Tourism Sector** in the upper reaches of the Panchyat and need of tourism department to pay attention.







1. That we have a school in our ward 3 , Panchayat Sarhi namely Middle School Nalla Banji. The building of this school was constructed some 30-35 year ago and it was a primary school building.
2. That now it's took 10- 12 year to up grade this school from primary to Middle School. But unfortunate for us is that till date neither the department granted any fund for constructing new building of Middle School nor grant any fund for repairing the old Primary school building, which has totally damaged and wooden furniture of building eaten by termites.
3. That due to aged and deteriorated wooden angle the roof of building up rooted in 2015-16 due to heavy blowing of storms. The staff of School forced to take classes in open due to not availing sufficient place or accommodation for running classes later it was temporarily managed with help of inhabitants of Village for temporary arrangement.
4. That since 2015- 16 we are continuously approaching the higher authority in written and orally. We already raised this issue in front of Back to Village program (Phase 2) Officers but till date didn't get any solution to our genuine demand.
5. That now the condition of School building has been such a worse that to run the class inside the premises is quite impossible and not free from dangers but due to not having any accommodation the staff of school still running classes inside the premises.
6. That it through your medium we the people of panchayat Sahri request to concerning authority to immediate repair and renovate the above said school. If there occurs any casualty the negligence of department would be the cause of such tragedy and department will be responsible for that.



4. That in this institution all the stream like Medical , Non-Medical and Humanities are available but no subject teacher is available.
5. We also approached Worthy Chief Executive Officer Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board Katra to engage trained Post Graduate Youth for the Current Academic Session 2022-23 through Worthy Chief Education Officer dispatch no CEO/Rsi/esstt/55-59 dated 13-09-2022 and Worthy Chairman DDC dispatch no CHDDC/RSI/PERS/2022-23/53 Dates 13-09-2022, as Baridar parents (Erst while Baridars of Shri Mata Vaishno Devi Shrine Board Katra) approached in this institution.
6. That the Academic session in winter schools is about to over.


It is therefore requested before your worthy self, Kindly provide teaching staff in this institution at the earliest to save the future of our students and take the necessary steps.
