## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
5. Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on [www.jkpanchayat.in](http://www.jkpanchayat.in) portal, before they leave panchayat.
7. Focus of visit are youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukt, bhrashtachar mukt, Rozgar yukt J&K, besides to carry forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and saturate them.

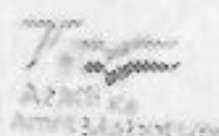

#### **Panchyats' Urgent Requirements**

- ✓ Ward No. 1 of this panchyat is totally underdeveloped, there is no proper main road, link roads connectivity's , there is urgent requirement of protection walls, electric poles with power supplying wires, Animal care centre, Anganwari Centre, PFS shop.
- ✓ Ward No. 2 has many lane, drain and protection wall issues while inspecting work done it came to notice villagers of this ward are using their own resources for lane and drain construction for example one frontline work of PPD Sh. Sat Paul Singh. S/o Lt. Krishan. Singh. R. O. Upper. Mandi. Raipur has constructed his half of lane from his own resource and left the work in middle. Similarly in Ward No.5 lane from the house of Sh. Dwarka Dutt to Sh. Randhir Singh has same issue.
- ✓ In all wards installed street lights are not functional only few of them are in working condition.
- ✓ In all wards(09), there is urgent requirement of electric poles, protection walls and replacement of water suppling pipe which are reportedly laid many decades ago.
- ✓ There is no Animal care centre in this panchayat.
- ✓ The Government High School and Middle School are in dilapidated condition and required immediate repair to keep the staff and student safe.
- ✓ This panchyat is comprised of 09 wards and there is only one PFS because of which villagers are suffering.
- ✓ There is no Forest Department's assistance in all the wards in respect of plantation drive
- ✓ In Ward No. 5 there is a pond near temple which can be beautified to make it a place for pilgrimage.
- ✓ In all wards water supply is not regular, reportedly water is being supplied twice in a month.

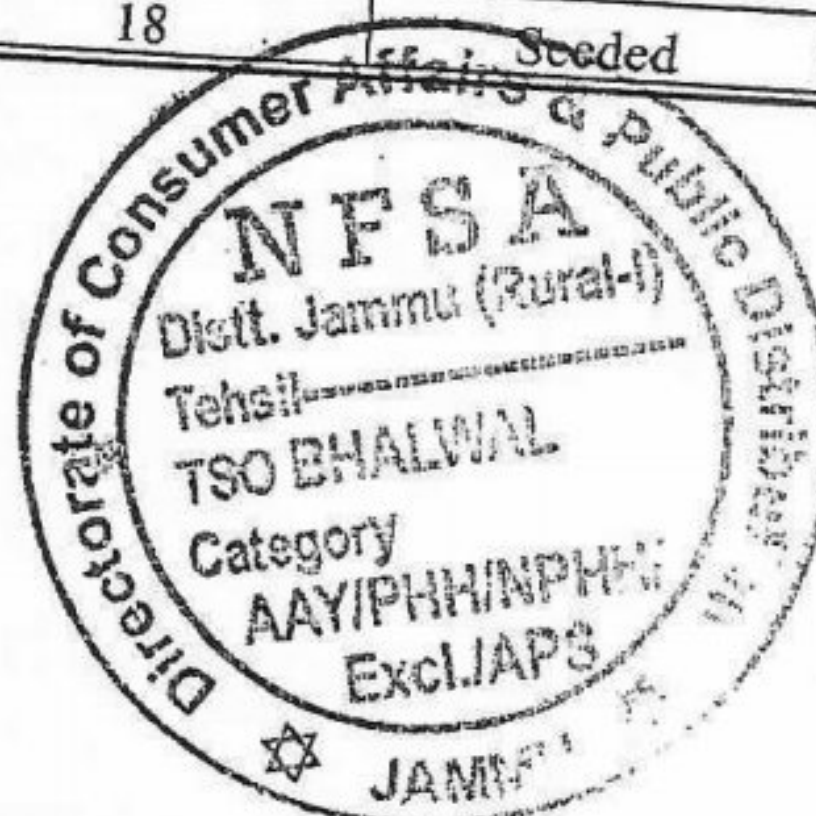

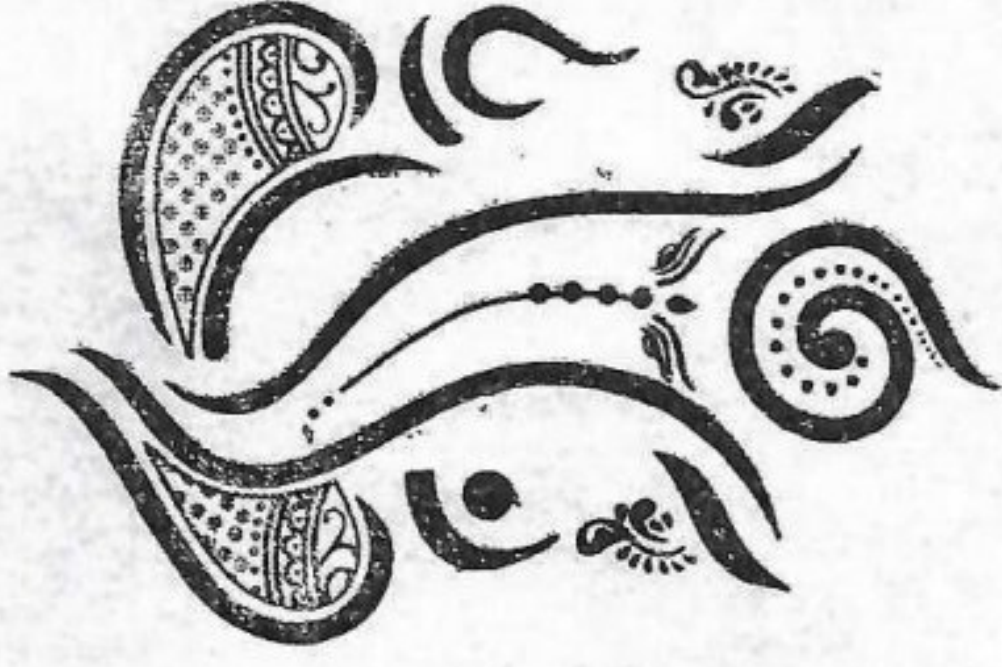
