

Major complaints:-

- a) Residents of Tariyabal area demand urgent provision of 6 electric poles, 3000 ft length wire & a transformer. The concerned residents complained that some residents of adjacent hamlets are stalling the project.
- b) Non-maintenance of road from Dan Mohalla to Soji Mohalla.
- c) Non-cleaning of irrigation canal.

Overall assessment & demands raised.

The overall assessment was result-oriented & public seemed interactive. Following demands & concerns were raised:-

- a) Demand for immediate macadamization of road along Dau Mohalla. Same is in shambles & very dusty.
- b) Pressing public demand to re-locate the Health Well-ness Centre in the centre of Watalbagh area.
- c) Requirement of complete fencing & gated entrance for GPS & GMS Watalbagh. Public demands upgradation of Middle School to High School.
- d) Requirement of 8 No. of electric poles along the road from Govt. Middle School to Sofi Mohalla along with provision of another transformer.
- e) Quality of drinking water turns muddy especially during rainy weather.
- f) Deteriorated timber supply. Public demands a good quality supply of timber.
- g) Residents of Tariyabal area demand urgent provision of 6 No. of electric poles & about 3000 ft length of wire & a transformer. Yd visited the same & found the demand genuine.
