# NOTES

## Overall Assessment and Suggestions.

1. Scarcity of drinking water is the major problem and it has been observed during the visit that people of the area are badly suffering due to shortage of drinking water. A Tanker used to supply water on alternative days which is thoroughly insufficient for more than 300 hundred households. It is suggested that this genuine issue of almost 80% of the population should be given top priority.
2. During the visit it is assessed that power transmission lines are not in good conditions. At most places people have used their own ordinary wooden poles to receive power and at some places electric wires are tied with trees due to non availability poles. At least one hundred iron pole is required to rectify these lines.
3. Construction of Anawari Road another major issue which was observed during the visit. More than 150 households are still 05 kilometres away from the main Road which add their miseria during bad weather when they have to carry their patients on shoulders to seek medical treatment. The issue needs immediate attention.
4. Establishment of primary Health Centre at main Dhami for emergency treatments. It has been assessed during the visit that people of the area are suffering a lot due to non availability of medical facility in their locality. This is also a genuine issue which need immediate attention.
5. Construction of Individual Bunkers especially in Farward Sudpura is a major issue. There is every apprehension of cross border firing and the underground Bunkers are the only solution to safeguard their precious lives. It is suggested that the underground Bunkers should be constructed to safeguard their precious lives from cross border shelling.
