## B2V4 Charter of Demands

During the B2V4 visit, the U/s visited various locations, Govt run centres, etc and had wide-ranging discussions with the local inhabitants of the Panchayat halqa - Duroo-B (Zangari). The following major demands were put forward by the public:

1. Completion of Drainage & removal of silt (Mud) along Duroo, Sepora Road near Jannia Masjid
2. Desilting and dredging of Zangari Canal
3. Removal of Encroachments along Zangari Canal
4. Upgradation of PHC to New type PHC with Ambulance and X-ray plant facility and allied infrastructure. Need of Gynaecologist as per the requirement.
5. Upgradation of High School to Girls Hr. Sec. School - Requirement of Toilets etc washrooms.
6. Electric poles, with wires for Alfurqaan Colony (Baghat Transformer) - Pandith Side <sup>20 poles with wire</sup>
7. Drainage system for Alfurqaan colony along the house of G.M. Pandith
8. Drainage along Zangari Canal near house of Asad Zargar, Sadiq Zargar onwards
9. Completion and proper Connection of Drainage along Masjid Duthal Islan, in consultation with all parties.
10. Upgradation of Bund Road along the house of Ust Ayaz Ahmad Mutt to Dangarpura.
11. Construction of office Building for ICDS Project office
12. Upgradation and widening of Duroo-Brath Road (R & B Deptt).
