



Though I Secieved Some opsinionnes Ogriefrances from public regarding execution of work by panchayal, but Panchayat was advised to take on board all the stakeholders of the village while Journalating their plans. It gives me pleasure to mention that Some long pending minor issues were ambientle amicably sesolved on Spot by Cooperation of Public and a some govt departments. The education sector and of the halga needs Special attention. The upgradation of BPS vilbose is die heed of the hour. Besides upgradation of Sus-Centre vilosse, reduction of monthly electric fee to some deserving families, redressal of already mentioned public demands/Complaints need special Consideration. I am thankful to all those departments like RDD, PDD, PHE, Flood of Controle, Police, Revenue, agriculture etc. and the Sarpanch with her team who made my visit so successful.
