

OVERALL- ASSESSMENT OF THE VISITING OFFICER

- SAMBA DISTRICT (COMPRISING 101 PANCHAYATS) IS HAVING OVERALL MOBILE NETWORK COVERAGE BARRED SANDHI VILLAGE (NONATH PANCHAYAT) WHICH IS SITUATED JUST 4 KMS FROM NATIONAL HIGHWAY RESULTING IN DIGITAL-DIVIDE OF MORE THAN 500 INHABITANTS AND COMPLETE CUT-OFF FROM OUTSIDE WORLD IN THE ERA OF DIGITAL INDIA. THIS IS CAUSING MASSIVE RESENTMENT AND INCONVENIENCE AMONG THE RESIDENTS OF SANDHI VILLAGE WHICH CAN'T BE EXPRESSED IN PLAIN WORDS.
SO, MOBILE CONNECTIVITY TOWERS SHOULD BE INSTALLED ON PRIORITY BASIS.
- ANOTHER MAJOR BURNING ISSUE OF PANCHAYAT NONATH IS IRREGULAR WATER SUPPLY (DAMAGED-ROTTEN WATER PIPES IN MANY PLACES) AND ELECTRICITY (INSTALLATION AND UPGRADATION OF TRANSFORMERS AND REPLACEMENT OF OLD POLES AND BROKEN WIRES) IN ALL 7 WARDS OF PANCHAYAT HALQA NONATH. PHE AND PDD ARE THE LEAST RESPONSIVE DEPARTMENTS AS THESE COMPLAINTS ARE LANGUISHING SINCE B2V1 AND NEEDS IMMEDIATE REDRESSAL.
- A WELL EQUIPPED VETERINARY HOSPITAL/CLINIC (R.S. PURA SKUAST TYPE MODEL) IS ALSO REQUIRED WITH X-RAY AND OTHER MACHINERY AS THERE IS NO VET. CLINIC IN WHOLE GHAGWAL BLOCK LEADING TO HUGE LOSS OF CATTLE LIVES AND LIVELIHOOD.
