



GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. The visiting officer shall refrain himself/ herself giving or offering any commitment on behalf of the government and shall adopt an unbiased attitude in reporting issues. As far as possible, his/her observation should be based on a fair and analytical view emerging from his/her interaction in the village.
- 2. He is going to the village as planning officer, not for sanctioning any works or for making any commitments.
- 3. While preparing village development plan, he has to ensure that, demands are prioritized and reflected under available schemes, wherever necessary the larger works are to be referred to administrative deptt under CSS/UT plans under intimation to DCs and rest of the works to DCs for reflecting it under district/CSS plans
- 4. His work shall be hard core planning and audit and is not a PR exercise.
- Every Deputy Commissioner has to ensure that atleast one RDD official (ideally Panchayat Secretary) is present in every panchayat with relevant panchayat records, to ensure conduct of all activities as planned. Panchayat wise order needs to be issued in advance.
- 6. Visiting officer should ideally carry his/her laptop to complete the reports at the panchayat level itself and upload the final report, duly signed both by the sarpanch and by the visiting officer on www.jkpanchayat.in portal, before they leave panchayat.
- 7. Focus of visit are youth, skills, self-employment, nasha mukt, bhrashtrachar mukt, Rozgar yukt J&K, besides to carry forward the activities during Jan Abhiyan and saturate them.
- 8. In addition attention may be given to the following areas

When I tried to Rnow the reason of anger, the joint reply was that larlier B2V programmes have not shown fruitful results, therefore, it is a futile exercise to farticipate on such events.

5 It was also observed during the said visit that Saxpanch concerned is very cooperative, humble & helpful and the whole panchayal is satisfied with his work and conduct. Therefore, I felt necessary that the said sarpaneh needs postive response on behalf of every department falling under his halfa while performing any kind of allinities in the said halfa. 4 The concerned SHO of Police Station Kulgam Showed positive uesponse as the officier concer-ned has made complete security arrangements for conducting the programme peacefully.

The frontline officers / officials who were assigned to the panehayat for the programme gave fortive response in conducting the B2V4 programme, especially the naib-tehsilour concerned, namely ramme, especially Rashid-rul-Hag. D, the said Naib-tehstidas deserves appreciation.

The concerned Staff of the Good. High School Standoo also remained present and gave each and every support during the whole programme. 49 am of the considered openion that after malyzing the work done by the panchayal halpa till date, lot of work has been done during previous B2V programmes. The work nehich has not been done till date, needs immedicate attention, henceforth.




