We Anganwadi workers and helpers are working in Social welfare wing ICDS Since 1974 till date. We working continue last 40 years in the said department . Now we request your good self in support our demands urging the State Government to enhance their honorarium at part with the adjoining state of Haryana, Punjab, Jharkhand, Maharashtra and Delhi, where as Rs 25000, Rs 20000, Rs 10500 are paid monthly to the workers. The State Government utilized the services of Anganwadi workers and helpers in more than 1 dozen department and central schemes regarding the implementation of various schemes and projects, but it is very unfortunate that the State Government never bothered to enhance its State shore to improve the economic condition of Anganwadi workers and helpers.
