The demands raised during the visit to Gram Panchayat Preng A, Kangan Block of District Ganderbal are as under with suggestions as per the observations/demands of the people of the area:

1. During the visit to Gram Panchayat Preng A, it was found that there is a dire need of 72k Bank branch to be established along with ATM facility for the use of general public of the area as in absence of the same, the dwellers face lot of hardships. Therefore, it would be appropriate to establish 72k Bank branch with utmost ATM facility so that the people residing in the area could heave a sigh of relief on this count.

2. It is also a felt need and demand that the Public Health Centre in Gram Panchayat is required to be shifted to the building of High School Preng and vice-versa because of the fact that the Primary Health Centre Preng location is not suitable for patients particularly for pregnant women and children being located at a very difficult and far-reaching

place for treatment. Thus, for the convenience of patients, it must be functional at the centre of the locality so that every patient could go and get treatment without any impediments. And, the High School Preng in the same way is obviously required to be shifted to the place where PHC Preng is presently functional. By swapping PHC Preng and High School Preng is a boon not bane for the dwellers residing in the area and is according to the Natural Justice as observed and as per the demand of the locals in the area. In addition, a basic amenity including manpower is need of the hour to be provided to PHC Preng so that patient care is taken of properly and proficiently.

3. The demand with regard to road (Jamia Masjid to Gujarpati) in the GP needs to be fulfilled and accordingly, macadamized from Primary School Preng onwards (approx. 1.5 Km) for absolute welfare of the general public particularly for the school going children pursuing studies in the primary and high

Schools preng situated alongside of the road in-question. Keeping in view the vulnerability of the children, macadamization is a priority.

4. As regards non-availability of boundary walls alongside the Nallah Sindh, the dwellers have apprehensions of any untoward incident, God forbidden! of floods that may occur and therefore, the people have demanded immediate boundary walls alongside the Nallah Sindh to nip the threat in the bud and could feel secure of life and property particularly lives of children pursuing studies in Primary and High Schools adjacent to the Nallah Sindh.

5. There has been demand of the public for establishment of GT9/skilled units in the GP so that youth of the area are benefited at large in order to get a dignified and respectable job opportunities in any Government or public Sector or could raise own units for the purpose of their livelihood.

6. There was overwhelming demand of the public for raising and beautification of Preng Park, which might be a tourist attractive place in the area and people

also get benefited by way of earning their livelihood.

7. Extension of playground is one of the demands of youth in the area for their recreation and health benefit—mental and physical.

8. The demand of a lady doctor to be posted in the PHC Preng has been put forth during Mahila Sabha. Further, the protection of ladies, installation of CCTV Cameras is required to be fulfilled.

9. Construction/upgradation of Preng-Panzandara Road from Gujarpati to Panzandara (approx. 1 km) has also been demanded by the people living in Panzandara.

We Anganwadi workers and helpers are working in Social welfare wing ICDS Since 1974 till date. We working continue last 40 years in the said department . Now we request your good self in support our demands urging the State Government to enhance their honorarium at part with the adjoining state of Haryana, Punjab, Jharkhand, Maharashtra and Delhi, where as Rs 25000, Rs 20000, Rs 10500 are paid monthly to the workers. The State Government utilized the services of Anganwadi workers and helpers in more than 1 dozen department and central schemes regarding the implementation of various schemes and projects, but it is very unfortunate that the State Government never bothered to enhance its State shore to improve the economic condition of Anganwadi workers and helpers. All other states except J&K after strikes are given there equal rights & their demands are fulfilled except us. Also other states are given financial year increment except J&K.

The honorarium of anganwadi workers and helpers has not increased for the last 10 years where as the price raised of essential commodities has crossed all the limits the poor workers and helpers are not in position to the feed their families. In this situation the workers and helpers are left with no alternative except to come on streets and raised in voice in their support below noted genuine demands for their immediate solution. Otherwise will be left with no alternative intensify the agitation till the settlement of the demands.

- 1) Enhancement of honorarium of Anganwadi worker and helper at part with adjoining states particularly Delhi states 12,789 and 6,498 respectively.
- 2) Fixation of final seniority list and holding of immediate DPC-meeting to clear at the pending promotions of workers as supervisor,
- 3) Release of honorarium of Anganwadi worker and helpers pending for last 6 months and back-log state share 6 months.
- 4) Pensioner benefits 5 Lac Anganwadi workers to 3 Lac Helpers
