During the visit the visiting Officer found that there was acute shortage of electricity and old wooden poles were about to collapse. People demanded installation of new creations as well as new poles with wiring. During the visit it was found that the three Govt. Schools of Pyl. Halga are located close to the forest area. These schools are without fencing and boundary walls. due to proximity of forests. there is threat of wild animal attacks on students. More there is need of attention towards Govt. Schools. Moreover the Habitations are scattered and there is no any Health care facilities. Hence there is Urgent need of Sanctioning of Health Sub-Centre at Kandher.
