MAJOR COMPLAINT: No major complaint was received

OVERALL ASSESSMENT AND MAJOR PUBLIC DEMANDS:

Under my visit to the Panchayat Aithi in B2V4 I have visited almost all the Panchayat and met many people, Groups of the concerned Panchayat and took information regarding the development activities initiated by the different department. The views of the people towards the dept. by and large are favourable and it seems that all the departments are functioning properly. But attention of Horticulture needed to be drawn towards the Panchayat so that interest of people for planting plants be created. (MAJOR PUBLIC DEMANDS).

The following few projects to be required sanctioned by the concerned authority for proper development of Panchayat being nearer to the Dist. Hqs.

- (i) A Park (Public) should be developed at upper nakka W. no 05 by the Tourism Dept. As there is thick population in the Panchayat being nearer to Dist. Hqs. and the people needs proper place for morning & evening walk (land available)
- (ii) The Play Ground which were developed at Gort m/s Aithi needs to be developed properly as projected in P. Gram. Panchayat for flourishing sports activities among the youth. As observe there is much talent present in the youth.
- (iii) A khul which was constructed by the Irrigation Dept. at W. no. 13 at Chappur Dam has washed away ^{due to the flood} needs to be re constructed so that the land can be used for Agriculture properly and yield more grain.
- (iv) A tractor Road for Gali to ^{ward no. 1} which provide link to 10 can be linked with main Road properly. So that people residing in the village can be linked with main Road properly.
- (v) A Tractor Road for main Road Drahali to Katana Mahalla be sanctioned in order to provide the link to people of the ward no. 1. So that Agriculture activities be going on and the per Capita income of the people can be raised.
