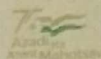

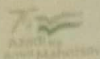

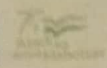

# NOTES

## Village Development Plan.

1. Construction of a Borewell: Water scarcity is the main and major problem.
2. Construction of a Dam/Sar at Pirdogor: The agriculture of the area is Rainfed agriculture. The dam will be a multipurpose project. It will be used not only for drinking water purposes but also for the irrigation. Pirdogor will also develop as a tourist site. It is pertinent to mention that recently Golab Valley Hotel - a multistoried building has been opened for the tourists, in Lalpasa.
3. Iron Electricity poles: In many wards, the electric wires are hanging on trees, and dilapidated wooden poles. At least 40 poles may be supplied.
4. Construction of Panchayat Ghar: The G.P. Lalpasa has not a panchayat ghar that badly hampers the functioning of the panchayat. Land has been identified.
5. Strengthening of PHC Lalpasa: Public health centre has shortage of equipments, ~~SD~~ technicians, water, electricity. (Solar plant is defunct).

6. Construction/Drilling of a Hand Pump in Govt. Higher Secondary School, Lalpasa.
7. Construction of 20 number of SBM.
8. Construction of a culvert in Lalpasa C.
